When you arrive,

- Check-in with a CAI-Illinois staff or committee member. Weather permitting we'll have a table near the front door, if no table look for the people with the clip boards. They will check off your name and give you a name tag.
- Proceed inside. A volunteer will hand you a small plastic bag and a hair net. Please put all jewelry in the plastic bag and either store in your pocket or lock it up in a storage locker. Hair nets are required in the packing room, and you will be asked to put on the hair net before entering the packing room.
- Proceed through the gift shop into the orientation room, find the FMSC check-in computers at the back of the room and enter your first and last name (there will be volunteers at each computer station to help with check-in)
- If you are volunteering with a group of colleagues, family or friends please try and sit together as a group. This will speed up the process of assigning stations to each group.

Accessibility for volunteers:

The FMSC Schaumburg site as well as individual packing stations are handicap accessible. Volunteers who have trouble standing for long periods of time may request a chair at their packing station, there are also sit-down jobs available (labeling). **Please contact us with any accessibility issues and requests – 847-301-7505 or aniad@cai-illinois.org.**

Volunteer guidelines:

- Minimum age for volunteering is 5 years old.
- Masks are optional for all volunteers and staff.
- No jewelry may be worn in the packing room. FMSC strongly recommends that volunteers leave all jewelry at home. You will be required to take jewelry off and place it in a storage locker before entering the packing site. The facility has a limited number of storage lockers available.
- Personal belongings such as purses should be stored securely and can't be brought into the packing room. The facility has a limited number of storage lockers available.
- All volunteers working in the warehouse are required to wear closed-toe shoes.
- FMSC recommends dressing in layers as the temperature in the packing room varies.
- Volunteers who are sick should stay home.
